Prayer in the present civil writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.3-Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, to decide the execution petition filed by the petitioners for executing the *Sanad Takseem* dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Balkar Singh, Naib Tehsildar, submits that *Sanad Takseem* dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) has already been challenged before the learned Financial Commissioner by the private respondents, wherein the matter is now listed for 30.07.2025 for final arguments. Learned State counsel further submits that the execution application submitted by the petitioners would be decided

by the concerned authority, within a period of six months from today, subject to any legal impediment and/or any orders passed by the higher authorities.

3. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the execution application submitted by the petitioners by way of passing a speaking order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties, within a period of six months from today, subject to any legal impediment and/or any orders passed by the higher authorities.

3.1. Further it is directed that the revision petition preferred by the private respondents before the Learned Financial Commissioner, which is stated to be fixed for 30.07.2025 be also heard and finally decided on the date fixed and not in any case beyond a period of four weeks thereafter.

4. All pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
