1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 4 to conduct fair and transparent enquiry on the representation of petitioner dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) and to take action against respondents No.5 and 6 and to arrest them in FIR No.15 dated 11.04.2024, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, Police Station PS NRI Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that it is a case where the petitioner had been victimized at the hands of the private respondents in connivance with the police officials who had earlier investigated the case. She submitted that after the investigation was complete, the police had presented a cancellation report before the learned Magistrate but the same was not accepted and the matter has again been sent back to the police for investigation. She submitted that her only prayer in the present petition is to the extent that now when the case has again come for



investigation in pursuance of the directions of the learned JMIC, then some senior officer be appointed in this regard for the investigation of the case because earlier also it was with the connivance of the lower police officials that a cancellation report was made.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.
4. Ms. Seena Sandhu, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents and has submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner now the investigation will be conducted by an officer of the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, she does not wish to press the present petition and wants to withdraw the same.
6. Ordered accordingly.
