1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 19.01.2025 registered under Sections 376, 120-B & 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Women Police Station, Karnal.

2. As per para 8 of the status report filed by the respondent-State in connected case bearing CRM-M No.7126 of 2025, the intimation with regard to the pendency of the present petition has been given to the complainant, however, no one is present on behalf of the complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 24.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
