Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 31.1.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal in CRR-176 of 2020 titled as “Shyam Singh etc. vs. Om Singh etc.”, whereby the petition was dismissed as withdrawn and the parties were directed to remain bound by their statement and not to raise any dispute with regard to the property in question. In the said order dated 31.1.2022, it was further directed as follows :-

*“....Learned SDM, Assandh is hereby directed to decide the case under section 145 Cr.P.C preferably within one month, from the receipt of this order. It is made clear that learned SDM, Assandh shall decide the case under section 145 Cr.P.C in accordance with law on merits and the order passed by this court in this revision petition shall not have any effect on the proceedings pending in the court of learned SDM,*



*Assandh under section 145 Cr.P.C. Moreover, it is made clear that order passed by this court in another revision petition titled as "Om Singh and Ors Versus State of Haryana and Ors" shall not have any effect on the proceedings under section 145 Cr.P.C pending in the court of learned SDM, Assandh...."*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 31.1.2022 (Annexure P-8) has been complied with by the respondent by deciding the proceedings pending under Section 145 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 30.4.2025.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing an order dated 30.4.2025 by the respondent; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 30.4.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

**Dismissed as not pressed.**

Rule stands discharged.
