1. The petitioner seeks grant of parole so as to attend the marriage of his sister-in-law (wife's sister), which is scheduled to be solemnized on 19.10.2025.
2. The petitioner stands convicted vide judgment dated 01.02.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, in FIR No.86 dated 19.11.2019, under Sections 302, 34, 148 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotli Surat, District Gurdaspur.
3. Pursuant to issuance of notice of motion, learned State counsel has today passed on a verification report and has informed that the factum of marriage of sister-in-law (wife's sister) of the petitioner has been got

verified and the same has been found to be correct and that the marriage of petitioner's sister-in-law (wife's sister) Harpreet Kaur daughter of Lakhwinder Singh is to be solemnized on 19.10.2025. The said verification report is taken on record.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and while bearing in mind the relationship of the petitioner with the person to be married, we find that the petitioner can be permitted to attend the marriage while in custody. As such the petition is allowed to the limited extent that the petitioner is permitted to attend the marriage of his sister-in-law (wife's sister) viz. Harpreet Kaur, which is to be solemnized on 19.10.2025, while in custody.
5. The Superintendent, Central Jail, Goindwala Sahib, Punjab, shall make the necessary arrangements for taking the petitioner, while in custody, to the venue of marriage of his sister-in-law (wife's sister) i.e. Gurudwara Baba Shri Chand Hall, Opp. Yuvraj Palace, Dera Baba Nanak by 10:00 AM on 19.10.2025, and to consign him back in the jail by 5:00 PM on 19.10.2025 itself.
6. The aforesaid order shall, however, be subject to the condition that family of the petitioner/petitioner deposits the requisite expenses including the conveyance expenses, which may be incurred for taking the petitioner to the venue of the said ceremony and to consign him back in jail, in advance with the Jail Superintendent concerned. It is however, made clear that in case the police officials accompanying the petitioner find that there is any development leading to apprehension or any threat

to security, they may get the petitioner back even before 05:00 PM from the venue so as to consign him back in jail the same day.

7. The instant petition stands disposed off accordingly.
8. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
