For the reasons stated in application, same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Copy of compromise dated 06.02.2025 (Annexure A-1) is taken on record.

CM-4476-CII-2025

Application herein for permitting the applicant-appellant to withdraw the main appeal in view of compromise dated 06.02.2025 (Annexure A-1).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the applicant-appellant submits that during pendency of the appeal, the parties have settled the matter and a compromise dated 06.02.2025 (Annexure A-1) has been effected between them. The relevant contents of the said compromise read as under:-

“That a divorce case bearing HMA No. 250 of 2020 titled as Inderjit Singh Vs. Beant Kaur was pending between Party No.1 and Party No.2 in the court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Barnala and the same has been decreed in favour of Party No.2 Inderjit Singh on 02.11.2023. Against this order, Civil appeal i.e.. FAO No.6416 of 2023 was filed by Party No.1 Beant Kaur in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh which is pending for 07.05.2025.

Today with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been amicably resolved/compromised and according to this compromise, it has been decided that party No. 2 Inderjit Singh will give Rs.12,50,000/- to Party No.1 Beant Kaur. Out of which, an amount of Rs.6,50,000/-has been transferred in the account of Party No. 1 Beant Kaur bearing No.158968899149 vide cheque No.977616 drawn on State Bank of India, Branch at Raisar on today i.e. 06.02.2025 and the remaining amount of Rs.6,00,000/- will be paid on the day when party No.1 Beant Kaur will withdraw her Civil appeal filed in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. According to this compromise, after today, party No.1 and Party No.2 will have no connection with each other. Party No.1 has withdrawn her Istridhan and other articles from Party No.1. Now parties No.1 and 2 have no other outstanding dues to each other apart from the said amount of Rs.6,00,000/-. Party No.1 and Party No.2 will not interfere in each other's lives. From today, the parties can get married wherever they want and live their lives separately. Party No.1 Beant Kaur will accept the decision of the Hon'ble Principal Judge, Family Court, Barnala dated 02.11.2023 (HMA NO.250 of 2020). Party No.1 Beant Kaur will withdraw her civil Appeal FAO 6416 of 2023 on the date of hearing or before the date of hearing. If Party No.1 does not withdraw the appeal then Party No.2 will be entitled to get the amount back given to Party No.1. After today, party No.1 and Party No.2 will not file any claim or revision or appeal or criminal case against each other. The aforesaid compromise has been made in the presence of the respectable persons which is acceptable to both parties.”

3. In view of the above and for the reasons stated in application, same is allowed. On oral request of learned counsel for the applicant-appellant, next date in the main appeal, which is otherwise fixed for 07.05.2025, is preponed, and the same is taken on Board today itself.

Main case (O&M)

In view of the order passed in aforesaid application, main appeal is dismissed as withdrawn in view of the compromise *ibid*.
