1. Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly concedes before this Court that the high tension wire has already been laid and thereupon the compensation has also been assessed, though the compensation, as assessed was of a meagre amount.

2. It is not disputed that in case of any grievance arising out of inadequacy of the compensation amount, the petitioner has an alternate remedy of filing an appeal under Section 16(4) of the Telegraph Act, 1885, read with Electricity Act, 2003, therefore, the petitioner is granted liberty to file an apt motion under the above provisions.

3. **Disposed** of accordingly.

4. Since the instant petition is pending since the year 2013, therefore, in case the petitioner files an apt motion alongwith application for condonation of delay, the same shall be considered most sympathetically.
5. All pending application(s) stand disposed of accordingly.
