AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Status report filed by the respondent – State is taken on record, subject to just exceptions. Copy supplied to the opposite counsel.
2. Mr. Harman Deep Singh Hans, SSP and Mr. Karan Sandhu, DSP present in the Court.
3. Petitioner Deepali has filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 8 to arrest respondent No.9 who was declared proclaimed person vide order dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) in complaint No.COMI/49-2018 titled as Deepali Vs. Vikramjit Arora etc. u/s 406, 498-A, 506, 323, 34, 511, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC. It was further alleged that respondent No.9 had no fear of law. He was roaming freely. In order to confirm this contention, one copy of FIR No.197 dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-21) is annexed where respondent No.9 was to give his statement in the aforesaid FIR.

4. In pursuance of order dated 05.08.2025, today status report has been filed where in para No.12 of the status report, it is submitted by Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Sh. Harman Deep Singh Hans, IPS that by making persistent efforts by the investigating agency, Vikramjit Arora has been arrested on 31.08.2025 from the area of Police Station Roja, District Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh. It was further assured that concrete steps will be taken by mobilizing Special Cell, namely PO staff for apprehending proclaimed offenders in District SAS Nagar. Investigating Agency has apprehended 46 proclaimed offenders in the last three months.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, learned counsel representing petitioner states that since Vikramjit Arora has been arrested by the police who was a proclaimed person, he does not want to pursue present petition and has instructions to withdraw the same.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

6. Mr. Harman Deep Singh Hans, SSP and Mr. Karan Sandhu, DSP present in the Court are directed to make sternest efforts for the apprehension of proclaimed person/proclaimed offender as per law for maintaining public trust and ensuring accountability in the Investigating Agency.

7. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
