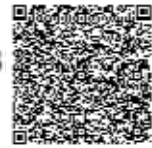

1. On oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioners, Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited, SCO 17-19, 3rd Floor, Sector 17-A, Chandigarh-160017 through its Managing Director is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No.5 in the main petition. The registry to make necessary changes in the memo of parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the newly added respondent No.5 to take a decision on the representation dated 23.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) made by the petitioners.



3. Learned counsel for the respondents, who appears on advance notice, have no objection if the above prayer made on the petitioners' behalf is accepted.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to take a decision on the representation dated 23.01.2024 (Annexure P-7), made by the petitioners, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and after affording opportunity of hearing to all concerned, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioners and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioners, they would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
