1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order passed vide memo No.3948 dated 3.7.2019 (Annexure P/1) and order passed vide memo No.6314 dated 04.08.2017 (Annexure P/2) as both order being non-speaking and the legitimate claim of the petitioner having been denied in a mechanical manner, being contrary to the Punjab Recruitment of Ex-Servicemen Rules, 1982, provision under Rule 7.20 of Punjab Civil Service Rules Vol.II and as such arbitrary, unconstitutional because the petitioner had rendered service under Air Force for the period from 27.2.1958 to 10.09.1974.

2. Today, the present case was called twice, but none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed in default, so also the pending miscellaneous application, if any.
