At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he restricts his prayer to the issuance of directions to respondents to finally dispose of the representation dated 10.04.2025 submitted by the petitioner before the jail authorities, Central Jail, Sri Goindwal Sahib, Tarn Taran Punjab for grant of parole as the same has been pending decision.

2. Learned State counsel has no objection to the acceptance of the afore alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the record, we find that the decision on the petitioner's request for grant of parole has been unnecessarily delayed by the State which is also against the spirit behind Section 3 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

4. In the light of the above, we dispose of the instant petition with a direction to respondent No.5-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to take a final decision on the representation dated 10.04.2025 submitted by the



petitioner for the grant of parole within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.

5. All pending miscellaneous applications also stand disposed of.
