Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is violation of the order dated 20.3.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-33428 of 2018 titled as “Partap and others vs. State of Haryana and others”, whereby the Civil Writ Petition was disposed of in terms of order passed in main CWP-2158-2020 titled as “Ashish Sharma and others vs. State of Haryana and others”, decided on 13.3.2024.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State points out that an LPA was preferred against the said judgment dated 13.3.2024, which was further disposed of in terms of LPA No.1007 of 2025 filed against the order dated 13.3.2024; which was further disposed of in terms of LPA No.105 of 2025 titled as “State of Haryana and others



vs. Damyanti” vide order dated 14.5.2025. It is pointed out that a perusal of the order dated 14.5.2025 passed in LPA-105-2025 shows that it has been observed by the Division Bench of this Court that SLPs have been preferred before the Hon’ble Supreme Court including SLP No.112/2025 whereby the Hon’ble Apex Court had stayed the operation and effect of the judgment. It is accordingly submitted that the order dated 20.3.2024 (Annexure P-1) stands stayed in the same terms as the abovesaid judgments.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the above said facts.

In view of the same, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

The petitioners would be at liberty to revive the present Contempt Petition subject to the decision of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in SLP No.112/2025.

Rule stands discharged.
