1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to grant him second ACP on completion of 20 years of service.

2. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana submits that petitioner was promoted on 06.04.1995, thus, he was not entitled to ACP. The petitioner must have retired on attaining the age of superannuation.

3. There was no representation of the petitioner on 05.03.2025 and even today, there is no representation. It appears that with the efflux of time, he has lost his interest in pursuing instant petition.

4. Dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application within 3 months from today, if cause survives.
