1. By this common order, eight writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as a period of 5 years have elapsed after the issuance of the impugned order and there was an interim order coupled with the fact that situation has changed a lot, the petitioner(s) intend to approach the Government with regard to certain grievances against the impugned order by which, the Government Schools were directed to admit the students provisionally who intend to join the Government School after leaving the private school, without obtaining the school leaving certificate so that neither the School nor the students suffer in any manner.
3. Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioner(s), the same will be considered with an open mind and all the grievances raised therein will be addressed by passing an appropriate speaking and the same will be passed within a period of three months from the date any such representation is received.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
