Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 05.9.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-22123-2024 titled as "Sandeep Singh vs. Punjabi University Patiala and another", whereby the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents to the effect that "*.....in case the legal notice dated 02.07.2024 (Annexure P-14) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, Jafter the decision any*



relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.”

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 05.9.2024 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with by the respondent-authority and therefore, she may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
