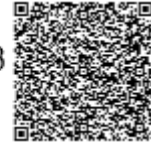

Since the issue as involved in the instant writ petition, has already been dealt with in detail, by this Court, while adjudicating upon a batch of writ petitions, the lead writ petition whereof, was **CWP-14622-2023** titled as **EMPLOYEES PROVIDENT FUND PENSIONERS WELFARE ASSOCIATION Vs UNION OF INDIA AND ORS.**

In sequel, the instant writ petition is also disposed of, in terms of the observation(s) made by this Court in its verdict rendered on 28.03.2025, upon, **CWP-14622-2023 and connected cases** and the respondent concerned is directed, to, in terms of the interpretation made in the verdict (supra), to the conclusions, as made by the Apex Court in paragraph No. 44 of its verdict rendered in case titled as **Employees Provident Fund Organisation and Another Vs.
