1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.10, dated 30.01.2025, under Section 303(2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1).

2. While granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court on 11.02.2025, the following contentions were noticed by this Court and the same have been reproduced below:-



“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the occurrence in the present case had taken place on 06.01.2025, whereas the FIR has been got registered by the complainant on 30.01.2025 under political pressure. Learned counsel further submits that in fact the FIR has been got registered by the complainant by twisting the facts. At the time of alleged occurrence, the petitioner had picked his own phone and the complainant has got the FIR registered by coining a false version. He next submits that the petitioner and the complainant are real cousins and due to some family dispute, the FIR has been got registered by the complainant. ”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 11.02.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
