1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.183, dated 05.06.2025, under Sections 21(a) and 27(a) of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Rewari City @ City Rewari, District Rewari, Haryana.
2. Status report dated 15.09.2025 by way of an affidavit of Dr. Ravinder Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Rewari, District Rewari on behalf of the respondent-State has already been filed by the learned State counsel, which is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 08.07.2025, while granting the interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 08.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Petition stands allowed.
