1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the complaint dated 15.05.2024 and 02.10.2024 (Annexures P-5 and P-4 respectively) given by petitioner No.1 keeping in view the facts and circumstances mentioned in the present petition. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representation/complaint dated 02.10.2024 (Annexure P-4) given by petitioner No.1 and to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security/police protection to the



petitioners because the petitioners are apprehending danger from the hands of respondents No.5 & 6 and further the petitioner be exempted from filing certified/typed copies of Annexures P-1 to P-5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for the redressal of their grievances, the petitioners have filed the representation/complaint dated 02.10.2024 (Annexure P-4) but no action has been taken on the same by the respondent-State.

3. Status report dated 29.01.2025 by way of an affidavit of Prithvi Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dirba on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions ASI Gurbhaj Singh, has submitted that on the appreciation of the representation filed by the petitioners dated 02.10.2024, the FIR bearing No.125, dated 29.11.2024, under Sections 329(3), 115(2), 191(3), 190, 62 of BNS, 2023 and cross case bearing DDR No.28, dated 24.10.2025, under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2) of BNS, Police Station Chajli have already been registered. He has thus submitted that no grievances remain to be redressed in the present petition.

5. Heard.



6. On hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the police has already registered a version and cross version at the behest of both the sides.

7. In view of the above said submission made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as such. The parties are at liberty to pursue their as available to them in accordance with law.
