The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.3-Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha to take a final decision on the application dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure P-5), submitted by the petitioner seeking allotment of 7 bighas of land, situated at Village Kansuha Khurd, Tehsil Nabha, District Patiala.

2. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior D.A.G., Punjab, appears on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from Ms. Ismat Vijay Singh, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha (Assistant Collector 1st Grade) submits that the aforesaid application dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) is

pending consideration before the learned Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha. It is further submitted that respondent No.3 (Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha)/competent Authority shall take decision either way on the application dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a period of five months from today.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 (Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Nabha)/competent Authority to decide the application dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner within a period of five months from today, by way of passing a speaking order and after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
