1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 28.03.2024 passed in CWP-7329-2024.

2. In compliance of the order dated 28.03.2024 passed in CWP-7329-2024, the Director, Sports Department, Haryana, has already decided the representation of the petitioner saying that the Sports Department, Haryana, does not have any control over other respondents i.e. district level sports associations. Otherwise also, tournament; qua which the writ petition was filed, already stood concluded. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the present petition.
