HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the Award dated 11.12.1998 (Annexure P-5) of the Labour Court by which, on an application filed under Section 33-C (2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (hereinafter referred as '1947 Act'), the benefit of over time service rendered has been extended to the respondent-workmen.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as, the over time was being sought by the respondent-workmen for the period ranging 1 to 9 days and the matter is pending for the last 25 years before this Court, the benefit could not have been claimed by filing an application under Section 33-C (2) of the 1947 Act.

3. No one is appearing on behalf of the respondents.

4. Keeping in view the fact that the claim being raised by the workmen was ranging from Rs.24/- to Rs.435/-, the same needs no adjudication at this stage hence, the petitioners be directed to implement the same and question of law is kept open to be decided in an appropriate case.

6. Any civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
