1. Learned counsel submits that the accused persons forcibly entered the house of the petitioner, who is 70-years-old illiterate widow, vandalized the property and inflicted injuries to her and family members while threatening to kill them, resulting in the fracture caused by a brick blow, reference in this regard is made to MLR, Annexure P-1, but no action having been taken, a representation dated 04.09.2025, Annexure P-2, has been submitted through her counsel, which has not evoked any response as yet. He, at this stage, on instructions states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if a time bound direction may be given to the respondent No.3 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S.Bajwa, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the representation dated 04.09.2025, Annexure P-2, expeditiously, in accordance with law, and if any threat perception is found or evidence surfaces substantiating her claim as regards to commission of a cognizable offence, after associating the petitioner, appropriate action be taken in accordance with law.
