1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.203 dated 28.09.2024, under Sections 318(4) and 61(2) of the BNS, 2023 at Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh.
2. In pursuance to the order dated 03.04.2025, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the same remained unsuccessful.
3. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner duped approximately 15 persons and amount involved is Rs.7 crores. It is also submitted that the petitioner had sought the interim protection from this Court on the premise that the matter would be resolved, however, she avoided to join the mediation proceedings and after joining, she intentionally refused to settle the matter amicably.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and file an appropriate application for bail and the trial Court may be directed to dispose of the same in a time bound manner.

5. Allowed to do so.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and files petition for bail, then the trial Court would dispose of the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
