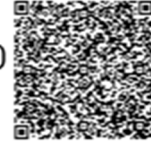

Second petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.0437 dated 03.10.2022 (P-1), under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

(2) Custody Certificate dated 04.05.2025 of the petitioner has been produced and which is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

(3) After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned Counsel for petitioner on instructions wishes to withdraw the present petition.

(4) However, learned Counsel submits that keeping in view the long custody, learned trial Court be directed to expedite the proceedings.

(5) Disposed off as not pressed “at this stage”.

(6) Since petitioner is in custody for the last 02 years and 07 months; therefore, learned trial Court is requested, not to grant unwarranted adjournments to either of the parties.

(7) It is clarified that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.
