Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.297 dated 15.09.2016 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 498-A, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of settlement agreement (Annexure P-2).

2. Today nobody has appeared on behalf of petitioners as well as on behalf of respondent No.2. Even earlier, nobody had appeared on behalf of petitioners as well as on behalf of respondent No.2 and the case was adjourned for today. Learned counsel for petitioners as well as respondent No.2 were notified about next date of hearing, even then nobody has turned up.
