Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the remaining amount of medical reimbursement i.e. Rs.16,12,980/- as per medical bills alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to her grievance, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 21.04.2025 (Annexure P-12) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2- Director, Women and Child Development Department, Haryana, Panchkula is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 21.04.2025 (Annexure P-12) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and she does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 21.04.2025 (Annexure P-12) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the abovesaid legal notice, if any amount is found payable to the petitioner, the same be also released in her favour within further period of two months.
