1. Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for alleged violation of order dated 15.10.2024, passed in CWP-26404-2024, titled as "*Suresh Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others*".

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, Addl.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and admits that in pursuance of order dated 15.10.2024 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was granted interim order in the same terms as in CWP-2340-2023, titled as *Jora Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others* (Annexure P-1 colly.) It is further informed that though initially, the petitioner was relieved, however, he has been permitted to re-join his duties.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that the petitioner has re-joined his duties, but an application for claiming the monetary and other benefits for the period during which he was not

permitted to join the duties is still pending for consideration before the respondents.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

6. In view of the above admitted position, present petition is disposed of. The petitioner is permitted to file a representation within 01 month from today, claiming monetary and other benefits for the period in question, which shall be decided by the respondents as per law, within a period of 02 months thereafter.

7. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
