1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.444 dated 29.09.2024 registered under Sections 3(5), 316(2), 80 & 85 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Naveen Sharma, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Udyog, Gurugram, on behalf of the respondent-State, has been filed in the Court by learned State counsel which is taken on record. In para 10 thereof it has been stated that since the petitioner has been found to be innocent during the verification of the facts conducted by the SHO, Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurugram and by the deponent, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
