SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Surakhsa Sanhita, 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.48 dated 20.03.2025 under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Firdkot.

2. Vide order dated 27.05.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3. Learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kotkapura, District Faridkot on behalf of respondent. The same be taken on record.

4. On the instructions of ASI Navdeep Singh, Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot, learned State Counsel has stated that the



petitioner has already joined the investigation and for further investigation her custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order dated 27.05.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.

The present petition stands disposed off, accordingly.
