DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

On 04.08.2015 to adjudicate upon the disputes between the parties this Court appointed Justice Ashutosh Mohunta, a former Acting Chief Justice of this Court as the sole Arbitrator. However, on appointment of Justice Ashutosh Mohunta as a member of the State Human Rights Commission, Punjab, an application was filed before this Court to appoint another Arbitrator in his place. On 20.04.2018, Justice Darshan Singh, a former Judge of this Court, was appointed in place of Justice Ashutosh Mohunta but on appointment of Justice Darshan Singh as Chairman of Haryana Real Estate Appellate Tribunal, the present application has been filed to appoint another Arbitrator in his place.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, Justice M.M.S.Bedi, a former Judge of this Court is appointed as the sole Arbitrator. However, such appointment would be subject to the declaration

to be made by Justice M.M.S.Bedi under Section 12 of the Act with regard to his independence and impartiality to settle the disputes between the parties.

The Arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings within the time limit specified under Section 29A of the Act.

The Arbitrator shall be paid fee in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Act, as amended or as may be mutually settled by the parties and the Arbitrator.

As per agreement expressed by learned counsel for the parties, for the sake of the convenience of their respective clients, the venue for the Arbitration shall be at Chandigarh.
