Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the Divisional Commissioner, Ambala to decide the stay application along with Executive Appeal No.46 (Annexure P-10), filed on 26.03.2025, titled as “*Lal Singh Vs. Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar*”, in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At this stage, Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana and Mr. Karan Singh, Advocate appear and accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and respondent No.4, respectively.
