Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.1 (Financial Commissioner (Revenue)-cum-Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana) to decide the pending petition vide Case No.01 of 2022 titled as “Suraj Sarswat & Another Vs. The State of Haryana & Others” dated 09.05.2022 (Annexure P-1), which is now pending for 20.08.2025, in a time bound manner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if time bound directions are issued to competent Authority/respondent No.1 (Financial Commissioner (Revenue)-cum-Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana) for deciding the aforesaid

pending petition (Annexure P-1), filed by the petitioners.

At this stage, Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to the State. Haryana)/competent authority within a period of ten months from today; after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition is accordingly, disposed of.
