1. Present petition has been filed praying for issuance of directions to the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, SAS Nagar to expedite the disposal of Superdari application pending in FIR No.16, dated 22.02.2024, registered at Police Station Phase 11, SAS Nagar for release of vehicle seized during the arrest of accused, whereas the vehicle belongs to son of accused (petitioner), who is not involved in the case and application is pending since 09.04.2025.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the application for release of the vehicle under Superdari is pending adjudication before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar since 09.04.2025 but the same has not been decided till date.



He has submitted that a direction be issued to the learned Magistrate concerned, to decide the same expeditiously in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. J. S. Arora, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He has submitted that the application for Superdari to release the vehicle would be decided expeditiously.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition is disposed of. The learned trial Court is requested to expedite the proceedings pending in the Superdari application for release of the vehicle and conclude the same expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within a period of 02 weeks from today.
