The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.27, dated 20.03.2025, under Section 25 of Arms Act, Section 29 of Arms Act and Section 61(2) of B.N.S added later on, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1).
