The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 28.11.2024 registered under Sections 332(c), 351(3), 75(2), 78 & 79 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Women Police Station Hansi, District Hisar.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Ravinder Sangwan, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hansi, District Hisar, on behalf of respondent No.1-State, has been filed in the Court which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 18.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
