VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of the orders dated 11.11.2024 passed by the lower Appellate Court vide which the application filed by the respondent LR for vacation of stay and impleading him as legal heir of respondent Manjit Kaur has been allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed an application dated 25.11.2024 for grant of extension of time to pay mesne profit and also for continuing the interim stay order in favour of the petitioner. It is submitted that reply to the said application has been filed on 09.12.2024 by contesting respondent no.1 and the said application is now listed for arguments on 10.01.2025. Learned counsel for

the petitioner has made limited prayer in the present revision petition that the Ist Appellate Court be directed to decide the said application as expeditiously as possible.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Ist Appellate Court to decide the application dated 25.11.2024 (Annexure P-10), as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one month from 10.01.2025.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the application and the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.

5. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
