Though the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.139 dated 27.10.2024 under Sections 140(3), 126(2), 118(1), 115(2), 351(3), 308(1) and 3(5) of B.N.S.S., 2023, registered at Police Station Doraha, District Khanna.
2. Vide order dated 02.12.2024, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 06.12.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation. Though, she further submits that three other cases are registered against the petitioner, however, registration of such cases cannot be made a ground to deny the benefit of anticipatory bail. The recovery of weapon has also been effected from him.
