1. This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 275 dated 09.06.2022 under Sections 406, 498-A and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom. Further prayer is made seeking a direction upon the official respondents to decide the representation dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law and within a time bound manner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have filed the representation dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) before Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to the respondents concerned to consider and decide the aforesaid



representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereupon.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondent at this stage only.

4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurpartap Singh Bhullar, Asst. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioners expeditiously and within a time bound manner, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
