1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the impugned order dated 19.12.2024 passed by respondent No.2 (Annexure P-9) vide which the order dated 05.08.2024 was stayed and also for setting aside the impugned order dated 16.06.2025 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.4 dismissing the petitioner from service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that by way of the impugned order dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-9), the Revisional Authority had stayed the order passed by the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Jalandhar, but the same has not been decided and during the pendency of the aforesaid stay order, the services of the petitioner have been terminated vide order dated 16.06.2025 (Annexure P-10) which is also under challenge before this Court. He further submitted that at this stage the petitioner limits his prayer only to a limited extent that the Revisional Authority i.e. Secretary (Appeal), Cooperation, Punjab, who had stayed the order dated 05.08.2024 vide

Annexure P-9 be directed to decide the revision petition in accordance with law within a specified time frame and the question with regard to challenge to the termination order (Annexure P-10) be kept open at this stage.

3. At this stage, Mr. Somesh Arora, Addl. AG, Punjab has submitted that considering the aforesaid limited prayer of the petitioner, he has no objection in case any time is fixed for the Revisional Authority to decide the revision petition in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of. Respondent No.2 who has passed the stay order is directed to decide the pending Revision Petition within a period of two months from today after giving an adequate opportunity of hearing to the petitioner or his counsel in accordance with law.

5. Needless to say that the challenge to the termination order (Annexure P-10) at this stage would be kept open.
