**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to release his leave encashment.
2. The petitioner claims that he retired on 31.10.2023 and till date he has not been released leave encashment. The respondent can, at the most, withhold gratuity and partial pension but leave encashment cannot be withheld.
3. Faced with this, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that competent authority would consider claim of petitioner *qua* leave encashment in accordance with law and do the needful within a period of two months from today.
4. Mr. Sheokand agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of.
