1. The petitioner has been working on daily wage basis from 1997 in the Forest Department, but neither is being considered for regularization nor for minimum pay scale, regarding which a legal notice dated 18.09.2024, Annexure P-2, has been served upon the respondents, which has yet not evoked any response. Learned counsel, on instructions, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

2. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 18.09.2024, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the
