1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 14.12.2018, under Sections 323, 325 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana in cross FIR No.298 dated 15.10.2018, under Sections 323, 325, 506, 307 IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the affidavits of respondents No.2 & 3 dated 18.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 (Annexures P-2 & P-3 respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised with the intervention of the respectables of the society. He has

referred to the affidavits of respondents No.2 & 3 at Annexures P-2 & P-3 respectively in this regard.

3. Issue notice to the respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
5. Mr. Shrey Goel, Advocate has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3. He confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.
6. In that view of the above, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.
7. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.18 dated 14.12.2018, under Sections 323, 325 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner shall stand quashed.
