By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.69 dated 01.12.2024, under Section 15 and 29 (Act No.61 of 1985) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

2. As per prosecution allegations, based upon a secret information against co-accused Veer Singh and Nishan Singh, 52 Kg. of poppy husk was recovered at their instance. In the disclosure statement, they nominated the petitioner besides one Sukhwinder Singh, telling that they used to purchase the contraband from the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that no recovery was effected from him; and that he is ready to join the investigation.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Neeraj Madaan, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

6. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is also involved in one more case and was specifically named by the co-accused to be the seller of the contraband.

7. Having regard to all the facts and circumstances, this Court consider that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner will be required to know the source of the contraband. This Court is of the opinion that it is not a fit case for grant of benefit of anticipatory bail.

As such, present petition is dismissed.
