The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the payment of gratuity and interest on delayed payment of pension and other retiral benefits to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case she is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Deepak Vashisth, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within two weeks from today, the same will be decided by respondent no.2-Director, Directorate of Elementary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months of receiving the representation.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
