The petitioner seeks issuance of a Writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the order dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-16) passed by respondent No.1 vide which he has reviewed his earlier order dated 16.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed in revision petition (Annexure P-1), after the said revisional order had already been implemented.
