Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 19.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-8550-2024 titled as 'ASI Rasal Singh No. 199/TT vs. State of Punjab and others', vide which the respondent was directed to decide the representation dated 06.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner within a period of 03 months by passing a speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that in compliance of the aforesaid direction of this Court, the representation of the petitioner dated 06.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 26.05.2025.

3. Copy of the aforesaid order dated 26.05.2025 handed over in Court by learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at the appropriate place in the paper-book.



4. A copy thereof, has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who after going through the same admits that the order dated 19.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) stands duly complied with by the respondent; and she does not want to press the instant petition any further.
