[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.12.2021, in CWP No.26676 of 2021 in case titled as '**Baljinder Kaur versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.26676 of 2021 was disposed of vide order dated 23.12.2021 by directing the official respondents to consider legal notice dated 12.01.2019 as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if found entitled and there was no impediment for grant of relief, to grant the same to the petitioner as per law without any delay.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 05.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 12.01.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that the

petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
