Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Vijender Hooda, HCS, Additional Director, Skill Development & Industrial Training, Haryana, who is present in Court, submits that the necessary approval from the Finance Department has already been accorded with respect to the benefits payable to the petitioners, which shall be released to them within a period of ten days from today.
