The present writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent-corporation not to effect any recovery from the petitioner pending the decision of the application for stay, which was filed on 01.03.2025 (Annexure P-2), in the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 28.11.2024/04.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 whereby recovery has been imposed upon the petitioner and it has been directed that the recovery be made from the salary of the petitioner.
